



THE CONVERGENCE OF NEIGHBOURHOODS

St. Charles Market abuts several desirable neighbourhoods: New Edinburgh, Lindenlea, Rockcliffe Park and Vanier.

The area has come to be known as Beechwood Village and has a distinct character and charm unlike any other community in Ottawa. The diverse and newly emerging strip along Beechwood Avenue incorporates the sophistication of Lindenlea and Rockcliffe Park, with the historically industrial Vanier and the affluent New Edinburgh.

It is lushly treed, just steps to the Rideau River and trails and is surrounded by shops, restaurants, sought-after public and private schools and a short stroll to the Byward Market.
